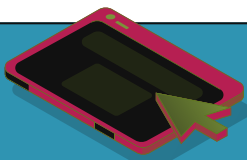

Program Enrollment

Applicants are contacted and assessed for eligibility/suitability for the Youth Voice. Program Eligibility follows WIOA In-School/Out-of-School Youth criteria. Applicants are provided information on the program and gather payroll documents to ensure Right-to-Work status.

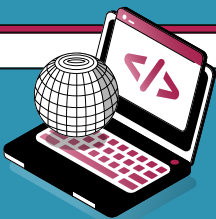

Professional Development

Program participants participate in workshops and activities designed to enhance leadership skills. Youth will also be introduced to workforce development and gain soft and hard skills, such as communication, teamwork, problem-solving, and technical proficiency.

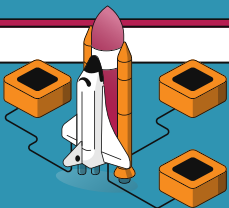

Paid Work Experience (WEX)

Students receive training in public sector aspects and guidance from experienced department supervisors. Participants will gain practical public sector experience, including customer service, teamwork, and leadership skills.

Youth Committee Participation

Students will participate in bi-monthly committee meetings designed to focus on connecting with professionals, policymakers, and fellow youth leaders. Coordinate with committee members and receive training in public sector aspects and guidance from experienced department supervisors.
